Safe Rider course details

The **Safe Rider** course consists of two evening classroom sessions and a road based session with a police motorcyclist (3:1 ratio).

You will receive a demonstration ride and have the opportunity for your riding to be assessed.

The course is conducted in a relaxed and informal atmosphere by police motorcyclists who are keen to help you.

Priority will be given to people who have received no post-learner training.
